問:這活動聽來很龐大,設計這項活動的目標是什麼?

答:這個名稱就是代表本次活動的目標,正是為了讓中一同學適應中學的新生活。其目的 也是希望中一新生能夠盡快融入於校園當中,使她們確切意識到,自己是本校的一份子!

問:至於這個活動同以往學校的安排有什麼分別?

活動回顧

Sports Day -----「全方位學習日 |





新型冠狀病毒肆虐,上年度的陸運會未能進行,而根據教育局的「學校健康指引」,學校 現階段不應舉辦陸運會等大型活動,以避免人群聚集,增加病毒傳染的風險;故此是年的 陸運會也不得已要取消。不過,縱使同學們不能籍陸運會揮灑汗水、靈活四肢,但也能透 揭「全方位學習日|讓頭腦靈活,掌握更多技能及知識呢!當天各級進行了不同精彩吸引 的活動,讓我們看看其他級別的同學,於當天有甚麼學習活動吧!

中一: 法證科學工作坊

厲害了!於法證科學工作坊,中一同學學懂分析血清 形狀,以及提取DNA,聽起來很是專業!是次工作坊 有兩項活動:一、從不同高度滴下果汁,再分析果汁 濺到地上白紙的形狀,以分析從不同距離所飛濺出來



的血漬,將有甚麼形態;二、以一根成熟的香蕉、洗潔精、咖啡過濾紙等日常生活俯拾皆 是的物品,從中提取DNA。同學除了動手做實驗外,也須先行聽從導師講解,了解血滴的 物理計算,以及DNA是甚麼——不説也不知道,原來人類和香蕉兩者雖然長得不一樣,但 所有的生物,包括香蕉和人類,都具有相同的基本組成分子,難怪我們可以用香蕉試試 提取DNA!

中二: T字之謎

相信大家都對「T字之謎」並不陌生——不錯,就是以

懂砌的圖形,就卡住進度了,教她們很是苦惱。

四塊不同形狀、不規則的積木塊 (稱為「T字板」或 「四巧板」),於一小時之內,拼出80種不同的圖形, 從而培養觀察思考、動手操作及邏輯思維等能力,發展空間觀念。據説遊戲其中的「t」形 是最讓人費煞腦筋的一種拼法,所以此遊戲也稱「T字之謎」。全級最快拼出全部圖形的同

學,還可以撰去參加學界比賽!當然有同學能於一小時內拼出70-80個圖形,但亦有同學表 示,由於遊戲規定要順序完成圖形,所以即使有些較後的圖形想到如何砌好,一旦遇上不

中三:數碼立方

至於中三同學的「數碼立方」(Soma Cube,又名「立體七巧板」),則有如「T字之謎」的進化版。「數碼立方」是由七塊「多立方體」所組成的一個3x3x3立方體,這些多立方體可以組成許多不同的立體形狀,驟看有沙發形狀、樓梯間形狀、摩天大廈形狀,甚至有駱駝形狀,真難想像幾塊小小的積木,都能砌出宇宙間各樣珍奇事物呢!但這遊戲尤其講求空間掌握能力,故此中三的同學最初都砌得十分頭疼,受訪者劉同學表示:「最初要順次序

完成各種圖案,真的很困難,我幾乎想放棄!看著積木, 腦海卻不知怎的,只浮現起麻將的形態!幸好之後老師説 可以不用順次序完成,我又重拾砌積木的動力了。」另一 位陳同學則稱:「我用了20分鐘才砌好一個圖案,這些智 力遊戲真的考倒我了!」看來真的滿困難呢,教小記都看 得心癢癢,禁不住動手砌一番!



中四:中國文化活動

中四各班進行不同中國文化活動,有編織如意結、製作花牌、剪紙、捏麵粉黏土。四班均有不同的大師坐鎮,原來這些大師均來自長春社文化古蹟資源中心,導師們大多已退休,但對中國文化遺產有濃厚興趣,故此希望透過教導學生,以保留、傳承這些傳統文化。讓我們了解一下製作這些手工,有甚麼小竅門吧!



陳師傅(編織如意結): 「手巧是很重要的,因為要好好控制如意結的鬆緊,還有要好好拿捏平衡與比例,例如編織蜻蜓時,左右翅膀都要一致。」





黃師傅(製作花牌):「別以為現在花牌已不流行,其實花牌仍然很受歡迎的,在店鋪開張、歲晚酬實、推銷等,都仍然見到花牌的縱影。製作花牌要敬捷,同時要不慌不忙,先用竹籤砌好花牌形狀,然後待膠水乾掉後,再黏上玻璃紅和熠花。」師傅更指出熠花才是最困難的部分:「真正的花牌是牌坊一般大小、上面滿滿都是摺花,所以要摺許多許多花,摺得人都健掉!」



馬師傅(捏麵粉黏土):「捏麵粉黏土講求耐性,不能太 著急,正所謂『慢工出細貨』!記著要用『陰力』,要慢 慢來、小小力,越是急躁,越不能捏出稱心的形狀。」



郭師傅(剪紙):「『工欲善其事,必先利其器』,剪刀的 尖銳很重要,所以剪紙要用專門剪刀,不是一般剪刀可做到 的。最初我給同學剪蝴蝶,是要讓她們練習對稱的技巧,這 技巧是剪紙必備的。要熟練基本功,才能剪出複雜美麗的圖 案,例如『鴛鴦相親』呢!」

看來製作這些中國傳統手工,不但要有一雙巧手,而且能從領略中國文化精神,正如孔子所云: 「無欲速,無見小利。欲速則不達,見小利則大事不成。」(《論語·子路》)做事如果過於急功近利, 不僅達不到最初想要的效果,並且還會適得其反。相信中四的同學們,也能從製作手工中有此領悟吧!

中五:桌遊體驗坊

雖然窗外烏雲密佈,但仍無損中五同學玩桌遊的興致!別以為她們只是玩玩桌上遊戲,原來玩樂背後,桌遊也同時考驗我們的計算能力、觀察別人心理之技巧,以及反應敏捷度。當天同學所玩的桌遊,都是一些平日較少機會接觸的遊戲,例如「大爆格(Blockers)」、「豬朋狗友之果盜檸檸七(Fruit Spy)」、「諾亞方舟(Noah's Ark)」、「豬朋狗友(Pick-a-Pig)」、「奶酪大盜(Cheese Thief)」等,受訪者余同學指:「這些遊戲很考腦袋靈活,而且要分組遊戲,所以亦講求和組員的合作。好玩指數方面,如10分是滿分,我給7-8分。」可是另外一位黃同學則表示:



「啊!全都要計數的,我數學最差的了,計得我很頭痛!」至於受訪者楊同學認為桌遊挺有趣:「在玩『奶酪大盜』時,我們要查出誰是偷芝士的老鼠,可是那些老鼠卻會千方百計掩飾身份,所以這遊戲考核我們的邏輯推理,以及要觀察別人的神情,看看誰是説謊的老鼠,很不錯呢!」不知道同學是否也對這些桌遊很有興趣呢?以後大家除了玩「大富翁」、「UNO」、「魔力橋」、「狼人殺」之外,也可考慮玩這些「燒腦」的桌遊啊!

中六:大學模擬面試工作坊

相較其他級別同學輕鬆快活的學習體驗,中六同學的活動則顯得具挑戰性得多 …… 不錯,面臨越發逼近的升學抉擇,誰還敢鬆懈呢?所以學校也特地安排大學模擬面試工作坊,好讓中六同學為即將來臨的大學課程面試,準備更為充足。同學於工作坊前須預先填好最心儀入讀之學系,然後將分成不同學系組別,例如社會科學學系、工商管理學系、醫護類學系、人文學科學系等,一同模擬該學系的面試及小組討論。除此之外,學友社的講者亦會講解大學面試準備及注意事項,以及教導學生適當的面試宜忌,包括儀容、妝扮、態度及問答技巧等。沒想到區區十數分鐘的面試,原來要兼顧這麼多東西,真的要好好準備才行啊!

Hey guys! Have you heard something new about our campus? Let me tell you one of them.

Our school is now having a new subject – STEAM – for our Secondary 3 students. As your stringers, we interviewed the teacher-in-charge of STEAM, Mr Henry Fung, immediately. Let's see what he said about it.

According to Mr Fung, our school combined STEAM and Project-based Learning, which is in line with our school motto – "loving-kindness" and the theme "gerontechnology", equipping our students to help the elderly solve their difficulties in daily life through the techniques acquired from STEAM. "Unlike other schools, we are not only focusing on the STEM techniques when teaching this subject, but also fostering altruism among our students," said Mr Fung.

When asked why our school initiated this new subject, Mr Fung said that our school intended to provide more opportunities for students to gain better understanding about the techniques and apply what they have learnt through the lessons. Noticing that the development of STEM is flourishing and the interest of students are great, our school then decided to reform this subject. STEAM can, in fact, not just involve science. A new element could be added - Arts, in order to match the specialty of our girls. Secondary 3 students are our target group as they learnt multi-basic computer theories such as programming and hardware control in Secondary 1 and 2. Such foundation enhances their learning effectiveness and abilities to help the elderly.

Mr Fung also mentioned that there would be some special events to be held in the future. For instance, students will have end-of-term presentations which are valuable chances to showcase their masterpiecesin our school's 70th Anniversary. What's more, outstanding works will be selected to join competitions outside school!

We also interviewed a few S.3 students about their views on STEAM. They were very pleased with this new subject and were looking forward to the upcoming special events. Some of them were very proud of their remarkable works and were confident in winning competitions in the future!

同學們,你留意到嗎?今學年,學校不同角落都遍佈了不同高度的圓柱體書架,而每個書架上都放滿了各式各樣的書本——原來這是「漂書」活動! 到底甚麼是「漂書」?書本也會漂流的嗎?相信大家都很好奇「漂書」的 具體內容及操作,以下就讓我們介紹一下「漂書」。

「漂書」指的是什麼?

漂書是「圖書漂流」(Book Crossing)的簡稱。別以為這是近年才流行的東西,原來漂書早已在上世紀60年代的歐洲出現,指的是指人們將自己不再閱讀的書,貼上特定的標籤,投放到公共場所(例如公園的長凳上),供任何人自由取得書本並閱讀。拾取的人閱畢後,再次將書本放在公共場所,

讓漂書活動得以延續。這種傳遞方式類似海面上的「漂流瓶」一樣:城市彷彿成了書海, 書本就在都市各處不停漂流著,想來也覺得富有意境!不同的是,如今書海的範圍縮窄成 校園裡的書架,老師、同學、來賓都能隨意取閱、分享自己心愛的書本,目的是讓所有人 從閱讀中得到啟發、樂趣、話題,甚至正能量。

「漂書」的靈感、書本來源

「漂書」主辦人Ms Lisa Lo 表示,原來她想籌備漂書這大型活動的欲望,已蟄伏有十年之久!當中原因有許多,如漂書在外國十分流行,想藉漂書來提高全校師生接觸課外書本的機會。可是在籌備漂書上,難免會遇到難題,如書本從哪裡來?將一部份圖書館的書放到漂書架,圖書館的藏書量會否充足?故此Ms Lo稱:「我們在圖書館裡找一些比較歷史悠久,又有文學修養的書本放在漂書架上,亦從其他閱讀愛好者,如校長、家長、舊生等身上得到他們捐贈的書本。」這樣便能確保圖書館有足夠藏書,亦使漂書架有充足書本。如同學有細心留意漂書架中的書,你將發現架上的書籍包羅萬有,主要包括知識、心靈層面及較為勵志、正向價值觀的書,希望大家看後都能有正面的生命觀,同時培養到學習及閱讀興趣!

舉辦漂書另一原因,是考慮到學生閱讀課外書本不足。雖然學校於一年一度的「世界閱讀日」都大加宣傳,提升師生閱讀意識,但僅僅一天的時間,難以培養持之以恆的閱讀習慣。 有了漂書架以後,學生便可以無時無刻隨手取書、挑書閱讀,隨心所欲。

思緒交流 ----- 漂書架的紙皮箱

學校裡共有十個漂書書架,並有一個紙皮箱。到底紙皮箱有何功用?原來,每本漂書架中的 書本都夾有一張紙條,讓大家寫下相關的讀後感,然後把小紙條放到紙皮箱,使大家閱讀後 的思緒、啟發有如漂流瓶內的小紙條一樣,分享至同學、老師、及各人,由此推動全校的閱

讀風氣, 並能培養同學的閱讀習慣。

戴着十字架的兩張新面孔 ----- 陳修女、翁修女

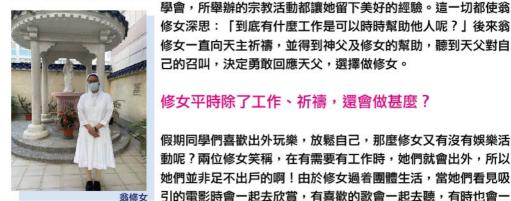

Hang in there, S.6ers!

After approximately 2 months, S.6 students will have to face one of the most critical moments in their lives – the HKDSE Exam – a chance to evaluate their efforts over their past 6 years of learning. In view of the epidemic, the commencement of full day face-to-face lessons is made impossible which significantly affects S.6 students' studies. The cancellation of exhilarating school events also deprives of their chances to enrich their memories in secondary school life. To gain some insights into the challenges they face during their preparation for DSE exam and their feelings towards their final year in OLC, seven S.6 girls were interviewed, and the following are the three questions asked and their responses:

- 1. Since the DSE exam is approaching, are you feeling stressed or nervous? Which subject do you struggle most with?
- 2. A lot of school activities have been cancelled due to the Coronavirus, reducing the opportunities to communicate with schoolmates and create joyful memories. Do you have any regrets? Were there any memorable moments you would like to share?
- 3. Any advice to share with our junior schoolmates about studying in OLC? Any advice for future DSE-takers?

Cherry Man (S.6B):

- I'm stressed because I'm worried about my Chinese Language result. My performance in this subject is very inconsistent, and my DSE grade will surely affect my JUPAS application.
- Under the pandemic, the time to study with my classmates or schoolmates is very limited.
 Some of my classmates have chosen to study abroad, and so we treasure every joyful moment together in school now.
- 3. I recommend that junior schoolmates should join any activities that they are interested in. Chances will slip away if you don't cherish them. Your time at school is limited, so treasure every moment with your schoolmates and teachers. In times of sorrow and hardships, don't hesitate to seek help many people are willing to offer assistance.

I also advise future DSE-takers to ask your teachers for help when you don't understand even a little part of the lessons as soon as possible. And when you get stressed or confused sometimes, talk to anyone and don't be shy to hide your feelings. Everyone is supporting you!

Cecilia Tong (S. 6A):

- 1. Actually, I'm quite stressed about DSE. As everybody knows, DSE result is crucial for our tertiary education choices. Among all DSE subjects, I struggle most with Chinese Language. It is difficult to thoroughly understand those complicated Chinese passages and answer all the questions. Marks are always lost due to my poor comprehension skills.
- It's a pity for Sports Day, School Picnic, and Thanksgiving Day to be cancelled. The change
 in how lessons were conducted was the most uneasy for me I couldn't speak much except
 when I was answering or asking questions. I also had much less contact with my school friends.
 - Nonetheless, the online school reopening ceremony and Christmas celebration were interesting experiences although the atmosphere of these events was not as strong as before.
- 3. Every moment and every person in your school life can mean a lot to you so treasure them!

Never give up and always try your best. That's the best thing you can do to win. Ask for help from your classmates or teachers to overcome your hardships together. There must be someone standing by you! God bless everyone.

Gigi Lau (S. 6D):

- 1. As the DSE exam is approaching, I definitely feel a lot of pressure. DSE is not easy for me, and it determines whether I can be admitted to university and which university I will study in. I think the elective subjects are the most difficult for me, especially Biology, which has a lot of vocabulary for me to remember. Frankly, I rarely use those vocabulary in daily life. For example, when consulting a doctor, I use Chinese to talk about my symptoms instead of the terms coveredin Biology lessons.
- Class suspension caused by the pandemic affected my relationship with my classmates. We could only meet online. We couldn't have lunch gatherings up till now.
 - Luckily, I still got a chance to join the English debating contest. We had online training conducted by the coach in the UK. I would say this was by far the most memorable event for me. No matter how busy we were, all debating team members spared time doing research and practice. The process was tough, but our efforts were rewarded as we gained improvement in English proficiency and above all, a trophy for winning the contest.
- Enjoy every day in school as time passes quickly, and soon we will graduate. Participate in
 as many school activities as possible because you will find the experiences very interesting.
 Classmates or teachers are very kind and always ready to answer your questions.
 - Never let your mock exam results discourage you. There is still half a year before DSE exam for you to revise your study strategies. DSE can be frightening, but as long as you see it as an ordinary school exam, you will find it less stressful. During my preparation for DSE, I realized that what I had learned in class was actually not enough. So after school, I will continue to do more practice to equip myself. But the most important thing is to do your best.

Toby To (S. 6B):

- Yes, I felt so stressed when I saw everyone around me attaining much better results in the pre-mock exam. I also studied hard, but I could not achieve my target. That was really frustrating.
 - Physics is the most challenging subject to me. The syllabus is tight, and it involves lots of calculation and difficult concepts. It makes me feel so dismayed. Luckily, my teacher sacrificed his time to arrange after-school tutorials for me and encouraged me whenever I was dispirited. I really hope to show my gratitude for his support and guidance through my big improvement in the subject.
- 2. One of the most memorable moments was singing and dancing at the end of the mass. We all had a great time performing on the stage. After every rehearsal, we would visit a café to enjoy the dessert and share our school life. Through helping with the Catholic Society activities, I also gained lots of chances to communicate with junior form schoolmates and enhance my organizational skills.
- 3. S.3 students should consider seriously about your choices of elective subjects which will directly affect your selection of university programs in the future. Language proficiency is essential to all of you too, so don't forget to polish your Chinese and English. S.5 students should work much harder. The syllabus covered in S.5 is of the upmost importance for your DSE.

For all my schoolmates, when any problems appear in your studies, tackle them with courage. Your teachers are always around to help and support you. Just feel free to ask them if you don't understand. And don't forget to enjoy your secondary school life and create memorable moments with your fellow schoolmates!

Eva Lai (S. 6B) :

- 1. I think Part B of the Maths paper is the most difficult for me. I'm worried about it.
- I had to stay indoors all the time because of the pandemic. It was hard for me to concentrate at home when having online lessons. Now that face-to-face lessons have been resumed, I still find it hard to adjust myself to the new timetable.
- I hope that the newcomers can quickly adapt to the new school life in OLC. Never give up until the last moment as life is full of turns and surprises.

Calista Lui, Charissa Lau (S. 6C):

- 1. The Chinese paper is the most challenging and scary for both of us.
- Online lessons cannot be compared to face-to-face lessons in view of its lower effectiveness

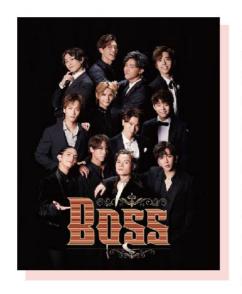
至最近新歌《All in One》:
